Men's Tournament and Activity Schedule 2010

Wednesday April 28: Men's Opening Wednesday Afternoon and Evening

- Men's Wednesday Afternoon and Evening Competition will begin on April 28 with an **informal** nine holes followed by a review of the tournament schedule, handicap information, slope, rules, etc., and conclude September 22. New members should make every effort to attend this event.
- Informal Men's Days will continue from September 29th to the end of the season.
- **NEW THIS YEAR**-----The Fines Home Hardware/ Shelburne G. & C. C. Cup.
- Prize winners: from each weeks competition will be awarded points from 100 to each flight winner to 1 point for the last place competitor in each flight. The points will be updated each week and kept on the Fines Home Hardware/ Shelburne G. & C.C. Cup leaderboard. The top five will receive prize vouchers after the final week.
- 1st \$150.00, 2nd \$100.00, 3rd \$75.00, 4th \$50.00 and 5th \$25.00

Saturday May 8: Monthly Medal – Entry Fee: \$15.00

The monthly medal tournaments which started in 2008 will continue this year. Along with our traditional Match Play, Best Ball, Club and Senior Championships, there are four Monthly Medal events offering Gross and Net Prizes. The top three winners in the Gross and Net divisions in each of the four events will qualify for the Monthly Medal Championship playoff on August 22nd. The qualifiers will play for the "winner take all" net prize of a \$100.00 gift certificate and a \$100.00 gift certificate for the gross winner courtesy of the Club. Each division is separate – no crossovers. That is: if you are in the Gross Division you cannot win the Net Division prize and vice versa. If the three qualifiers in the May 5th event (3 Gross, 3 Net) place in the top three in the June 6th, July 4th or August 22nd events the next player(s), 4th, 5th, 6th etc will qualify for the playoff, ensuring that twelve* players will play in the final in each of the two divisions.* To qualify for the "Gross" division you must have a handicap of 9 or under.

Important: the format for all monthly medals will be conducted on a non formal basis, that is: you will make your own tee time, play before 11:00am, pay your \$15.00 entry fee on the day of play, with the only stipulation that you play with a fellow member who will keep and attest your score.

The prizes for each Monthly Medal will be determined by the number of entrants for each event with a maximum of three gross and ten net winners. The prizes for the Championship playoff are sponsored and paid for by the Club.

Monday May 10: Senior Men's Competition begins

Saturday May 15: Men's Opening Four Man Scramble 8:00 am shotgun - each team will be formed as equitable as possible with a player from A, B, C, and D flights

Sunday May 16: Spring Championship \$15.00: The low 16 net scores in the Spring Championship will qualify for the Match Play Championship. 50% of the entry fee will go to prizes for the Spring and 50% will go to the Match Play prizes. . Ties will be broken by GAO Rules for 16th place.

New members must have 5 differentials registered in the computer before playing the Qualifying round.

- **Men's Match Play Championship: \$15.00** Men's Match Play qualifying will run from May 22nd to the 29th. The final seeds for the Match Play Championship will be determined from the low 48 net scores from the qualifying round. Those who do not qualify and first round losers in the Match Play event will have the opportunity to play in the Consolation Match for a \$15.00 entry fee.

CO-ED Match Play Championship: \$20.00 per team. Must enter by May 30th.

**Seven day Members only. Full handicap, Lowest net score on each hole wins.
Prizes will be awarded 50% to 1st, 30% to 2nd and 12.5 % to 3rd and 4th**

***Saturday, July 10 and Sunday July 11: Senior Championship –Both Rounds – 8:00am (+ -) tee times - Closing Date - July 1**

- 36 hole total Gross and Net (A & B Flight and Super Seniors- 65 and over) Members must have a minimum of TEN 2010 differentials to enter.

***August 7 & 8 & 14: Club Championship - 8:00 am Tee Times - Closing Date: July 29**

- A Flight – Must be 9.0 index or lower. 54 hole total – August 7, 8 & 14 - Black Tees
- B, C & D flights will be divided equally into divisions from 9.1 index and up
- B Flight 54 hole total August 7, 8 & 14 - Blue Tees
- C&D Flights 36 hole total August 7 & 8 only - Blue Tees

If a “B” flight contestant wishes to compete for the Club Championship he must play the Black Tees in “A” Flight division.

Advanced Juniors with Intermediate Memberships are eligible for the Men’s Club Championship.

George S. Lyon Team: The George S. Lyon team championship in September will be composed of the low **four** finishers at the completion of the 54 hole Club Championship. If any of the top four cannot attend the tournament, the fifth place finisher in the Club Championship will be the first alternate, the sixth place will be second alternate etc. The George S. Lyon Team entry is the responsibility of the Team members.

- The Champions of the Match Play, Best Ball, Senior & Club Championships each receive a club-crested memento.
- To enter any of the above tournaments, participants must sign the 2010 rules and conditions.
- To play in the weekend tournaments, participants must be seven day members.
- All contestants must sign up in person for each tournament.
- All tournaments have a closing date eight days prior to the tournament date (ie Friday for the following Sunday)
- Entries after the closing date will be accepted only if the draw is not full and there is an opening in your division.
